Sub: Second Five Year Plan - Primary and Basic Education - Basic Training Institutions - Establishment of a Sponsored Senior Basic Training College for Women at 98, Beltola Road, Calcutta.

Ref: His U.O. No. 1404 dated the 24th November, 1959.

In conformity with the principles for development of Basic Education and the policy for expansion of teachers' training facilities, the State Government have formulated proposals for the setting up of Senior Basic Training Colleges for the training of Under-Graduate teachers under the above scheme.

2. The Government of India in the Ministry of Education in their letter No. F.4-4/57 G.U. of the 5th February, 1957, have agreed to bear 60% of the cost of the scheme.

3. The scheme as drawn up by the Director of Public Instruction, West Bengal has been carefully considered and the Governor is now pleased to approve of the establishment of a Senior Basic Training College for under-graduate teachers (I.A. and I.Sc.) at premises No. 98, Beltola Road, Calcutta required by Government. The college will be conducted as a sponsored institution by a Governing Body duly constituted. A separate order will issue, in due course, in that respect. The buildings, land, equipment, furniture etc. will remain Government property, with the Department of Education, who will be responsible for maintenance, repairs etc. to house the college property.

4. Sanction of the Governor is now recorded to the scale of non-recurring and recurring expenditure, as shown in the annexure, in connection with the establishment of a Sponsored Senior Basic Training College for Women, at 98, Beltola Road, Calcutta.

The College will provide for one year course of training for 120 trainees. The first session will commence from January, 1960 with a full complement of 120 trainees, by some adjustment, from November, 1960 with the extent of actual requirement for 60 trainees.

The construction projects of the College including repairs will be undertaken by the Chief Engineer, Construction Board, West Bengal. The expenditure during 1959-60 should be limited to Rs. 96,800/- only. The charge on construction projects etc. will be met from the provision under the head "P.A. of Civil Works outside the Revenue Account-F.Dev. Schemes-Education-Primary and Basic Education - Basic Training Institutions". The works & estimates Deptt. are being requested to place necessary funds at the disposal of the Chief Engineer, Construction Board, West Bengal on requisition.

The charge on account of expenditure on items other than construction projects will be met from the provision under the head "Development Schemes-Second Five Year Plan-Elementary Education-Basic Training Institutions" in the "57-Education" Budget.

The Accountant General, West Bengal has been informed.
